

WHAT IS THE PROJECT'S PURPOSE?

The purpose of the project is to replace the structurally deficient bridge that carries Shannon Drive (S-384) over Brushy Creek. Although the "structurally deficient" status identifies the bridge as having one or more structural issues that require attention, the bridge is currently safe for vehicle traffic.

HOW IS THE PROJECT FUNDED?

With an estimated cost of \$2.3 million, the proposed Shannon Drive Bridge Replacement Project will utilize both state and federal funds from the Off-System Bridge Replacement Program identified in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Project Location and Proposed Detour Route

WELCOME

On behalf of the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), welcome to the Public Information Meeting for the proposed Shannon Drive (S-384) over Brushy Creek Bridge Replacement Project. The purpose of this meeting is to provide you with an opportunity to review and discuss the proposed bridge replacement project with representatives from the Project Team. This meeting is being conducted with an informal, drop-in format. Exhibits are on display that depict the Preferred Alternative for the project. Multiple methods are also being offered for you to provide us with your important feedback regarding the proposed improvements. **Thank you for your participation!**

WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

SCDOT proposes to replace the Shannon Drive over Brushy Creek bridge with a new bridge in the same location, minimizing impacts. The existing 45-foot long by 28-foot wide, timber-pile bridge was constructed in 1965 and is currently load restricted. The proposed new bridge is 140 feet long, 39 feet wide, and supported by concrete columns. This project is part of SCDOT's Strategic 10-year Plan to greatly reduce the number of closed and load restricted bridges in South Carolina.

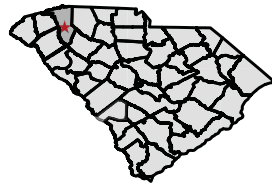
To expedite completion of the project and minimize impacts, SCDOT intends for the bridge to be closed and traffic to be detoured during construction, which is anticipated to take approximately 12 months. The proposed detour (refer to map above) uses East North Street (S-94), Richbourg Road (S-385), and Edwards Road (S-304) for a total detour length of about 1.5 miles.
