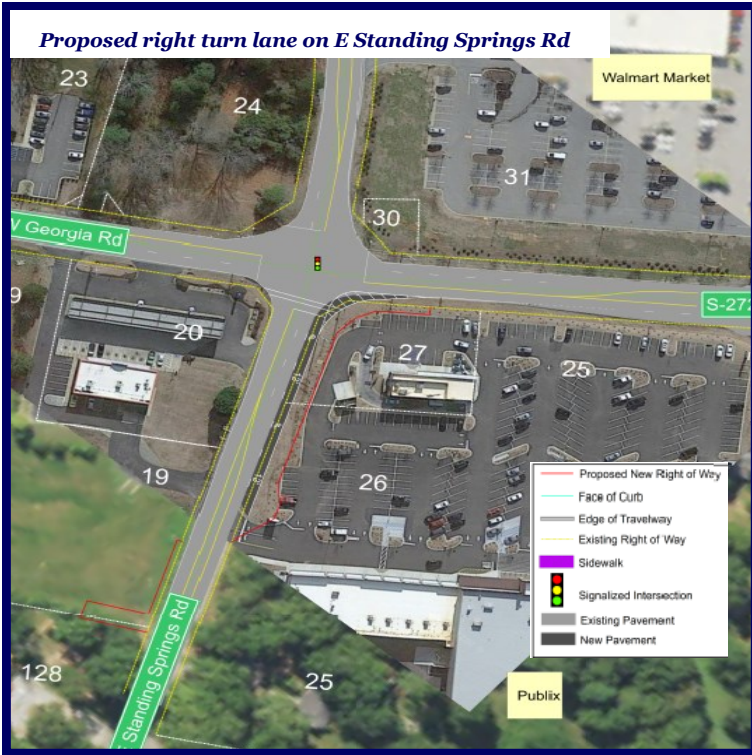

PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this proposed project is to address existing and projected undesirable delays at the intersections of (S-453) Rock Creek Rd, (L-1155) East Standing Springs Rd, and (L-2711) Neely Ferry Rd while also improving safety within the project area along the (S-272) West Georgia Rd corridor.

PROJECT FUNDING

This project will be federally and locally funded through SCDOT and the City of Simpsonville. The total project budget is approximately \$3.5 Million.



RIGHT OF WAY

While minimal right-of-way acquisition is the goal for all projects, some right-of-way will need to be acquired by SCDOT to complete the project. All right-of-way will be acquired in conformance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, or the Uniform Act. TITLE VI COMPLIANCE

SCDOT complies with all requirements set forth by federal regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation under the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. The complaint should be submitted no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged act of discrimination. It should outline as completely as possible the facts and circumstances of the incident and should be signed by the person making the complaint.
